

Boulder Bike Ambassador (BA) Job Description

Walk & Bike Month (W&BM) & Community Cycles (CC) is hiring 2 Bicycle Ambassadors (BAs) for safety and outreach activities from June to September. Ambassadors will be hired and supervised by the W&BM director in June and the Community Cycles director from July – September. Ambassadors will be paid \$12 per hour (as 1099 contractors). This job is part time, 12- 15 hours a week, depending on events and runs from June 1 – September 11th

BAs will work with the community at the Farmer's Market, CC's Rolling Bike Clinics, the Family Learning Center, CU and other community events, schools, recreation centers and worksites to teach specific skills that encourage safe and convenient use of Boulder's roadways, paths and transit routes (such as bike helmet fit, bike handling skills, fixing a flat bike tire, putting your bike on the bus, reading a transit schedule and route map, rules of the road/path,).

Candidates should be comfortable speaking in front of a group and interacting with the public in large groups, as well as one-on-one.

BAS WILL BE WORKING ALMOST ALL SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS FROM JUNE TO SEPTEMBER. BAs must have their own working bicycle and cell phone. BAs will be required to bicycle to most events on their bike; sometimes with a bike trailer (bike trailer will be provided by W&BM/ CC). BAs may be required to carry heavy items in the bike trailer. BAs will need to be able to be reached on their cell phones by the W&BM/ CC director if they are working an event.

Ability to speak Spanish and bicycle mechanic skills are not required, but are a plus.
